Please note - If an athlete's level is not offered, the athlete may enter the next level up. If the athlete should place 1st in that event, the win counts as 1 win in their current level and does not require the athlete to change status level (as per NBTA rules).

U.S. ENTRIES – Please note that U.S. participants will pay in Canadian funds and do not need to be a member of the CNBTA organization. Please keep in mind that the CNBTA insurance coverage will **NOT** be applicable to U.S. contestants. This contest is approximately 2.5 hours from the Buffalo border.

Set System: A Set System will be used for all events. A copy of it will be forwarded to all coaches the week of the competition.

Gymnastics: Please refer to the current CNBTA rulebook for information on events which do/do not allow gymnastics.

Music: All events use the Standard WFNBT Music for each individual event. This motion was passed by CNBTA Technical Committee summer 2016. All Rhythmic and Team music is to be submitted to our CNBTA Dropbox link that will be sent to all coaches. Music should be uploaded to Dropbox no later than **March 15, 2023**.
Clearly indicate the following: ATHLETES NAME (First Name, Last Name, Division, Event)
Example: Sarah Smith, Senior B Rhythmic

CUP event

We are excited by the ideas our Club Athlete's rep and our CNBTA athletes Rep came up with to freshen this event and hopefully encourage more participation as we head into a new era of twirling. We hope the ways we have listened to the athletes will help you all feel encouraged to give CUP a try this year.

PLEASE NOTE: Wins in the cup event will count towards regular advancement

Regional Cup Winner & Champion event

- 2 Age groups Junior (14 years and under) Senior (15 years and over)
- 4 Levels: Novice, Beginner, Intermediate, Advance
- This is a 3-part event (2 part for Novice) that will help athletes develop an all-around twirl base as well as be able to compete in events like Twirlmaniac Challenge, Gold Invitational, Congressional Cup All-around, and Invitational events.
- Level is determined by your SOLO level
- Novice- Solo & 2Baton events Only Beginner– Solo, 2-Baton, Solo Dance event
- Intermediate- Solo, 2Baton & Rhythmic (or solo dance your choice however event will be judged together) Advance (Solo, Multi Baton (combination of 2/3/4 baton you can do just 2 baton, you can combine 2-3 baton, you can combine 2-3-4 baton, Rhythmic event. Place points will be used, scores will only be used in tie breaking situations.

All CNBTA rules and regulations will be in effect and enforced. The Regional Pageant will follow the NBTA rules and regulations regarding combined events and dress regulations for each level of the pageant. Judges' decisions are final. Tabulated results are final 48 hours after the completion of the competition day. Any issues regarding the results of the contest coaches are asked to complete the "result conflict form" found online or at contest. Any other concerns regarding events at the contest coaches are asked to please contact the Contest Director in writing at the end of the contest and CNBTA will contact you within 7 business days.
